The President Hotel starts its fourth year with Five Stars

The commission of AHR CR has awarded the Hotel's efforts to comply with its strict requirements for the quality of services, and on August 9, 2007 it issued the Class Mark and a Certificate declaring the President Hotel a five-star hotel.

This year has also seen the President Hotel becoming a member of the „Utell Luxury Collection“ which associates with the world's most luxurious hotels. Since 2004, when the President was re-opened after a major reconstruction, it has become one of the most popular Prague hotels with its great location, modern facilities and extensive offer of first-class services, attracting more and more guests to the Hotel each year.

- The base stone of President Hotel was set in 1928 by decision of the Czech Association of Engineers and Architects (SIA) to build up a representative seat of their organisation. In 1978, the attractive place next to SIA building was chosen for the imposing project of a hotel. Immediately after it was finished, the hotel, in that time called Budovatel, was joined with the original SIA building. In 1984, the building was rebuilt in the so-called monolithic style. In 2002, during the destructive floods President Hotel was heavily affected and had to be closed. The refurbishment started on 1st of August, 2003 and was completed on 6th of August, 2004.
- Since 1992, President Hotel – Casino Praha is being owned by Spanish company Comar which runs a chain of prestigious casinos all over the world.
